

Amendment No. 3 to “Back to Shul” Plan

Given that Dauphin County has moved from "moderate" community transmission of COVID-19 to "substantial" transmission, and given the CDC's recommendation as to the appropriate policies for such areas, Temple Ohev Sholom will fully reinstate our mask requirement, which we had relaxed in July based on conditions at that time. All individuals must resume wearing masks in our buildings regardless of vaccination status, effective immediately. The Board will continue to modify policies as appropriate and notify the membership of those changes. The Board has not yet made a final decision on masking for the High Holidays specifically, but we will do so in the near future.
