Help us to be open-hearted to any and all others seeking knowledge, community and spirituality within our doors. Work with us to manifest our faith's teaching that redemption comes only through acts of righteousness. May we learn from you.

Rabbi Jasper: May I learn from you. Congregation: Be a friend to us.

Rabbi Jasper: Be friends to me and to my loved ones.


Congregation: Be an example to us. Rabbi Jasper: Be examples to me.
